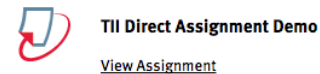


Turnitin Direct Assignment Guide for Students

The work that you submit in Blackboard using *Turnitin Direct Assignment* is checked for plagiarism, in other words for similarities to other texts. A report is produced once the check is complete. This sets out which parts of the text bear similarities and where the sources can be found. Depending on the settings that the lecturer sets for the assignment, you may or may not view the results. This guide describes how to submit an assignment and what conditions you have to accept.

Opening an assignment

- Open the course in Blackboard and go to the folder where the assignment is located.
- Click on *View Assignment*



- In the next screen, open the *Submit* tab



You will be shown a screen with a UvA notification requesting you to accept the terms of the 'Turnitin User Agreement'.

Note that the following screen will display a licence agreement for the use of Turnitin plagiarism software. As the UvA has concluded a separate campus agreement with the software supplier about the use of Turnitin, the licence agreement shown is not applicable. However, the supplier is as yet not technically able to show the correct contract terms online. The UvA requests that you tick 'I agree' on the next page. If you have any questions about this, please contact the ICTS Service Desk.

- To submit your work, you have to agree to the conditions by clicking on 'I agree'.

Submitting assignments

- For *Submission Method*, select whether you will enter the text directly in an editor or whether you will submit a file.
- For *Submission Title*, enter a title for your work.
- If your lecturer wishes to receive your assignment in multiple parts, enter which part you are submitting in the *Submission Part* field.
- At *File to Submit*, click on the *Choose File* button to select the file you want to submit. You may also drag the file to the *Choose File* button.
- Tick the *Notice* check box to indicate that you have read the text below.
