

## Turnitin Direct Assignment Guide for students

The work that you submit in Blackboard using *Turnitin Direct Assignment* is checked for plagiarism, in other words for similarities to other texts. A report is produced once the check is complete. This sets out which parts of the text bear similarities and where the sources can be found. Depending on the settings that the lecturer sets for the assignment, you may or may not view the results. This guide describes how to submit an assignment and what conditions you have to accept.

### Opening an assignment

- Open the course in Blackboard and go to the folder where the assignment is located.
- Click on *View Assignment*

### Accepting the conditions

- In the next screen, open the *Submit* tab

When you submit a Turnitin assignment for the first time, the *Turnitin User Agreement* is displayed.

To submit your work, you have to agree to the conditions by clicking on '*I agree*'.

These are in line with the Regulations governing Fraud and Plagiarism (A-Z-list [Plagiarism and Fraud](#)) of the UvA (see Article 3 – Detection of plagiarism).

### Submitting assignments

- For *Submission Method*, select whether you will enter the text directly in an editor or whether you will submit a file.
- For *Submission Title*, enter a title for your work.
- If your lecturer wishes to receive your assignment in multiple parts, enter which part you are submitting in the *Submission Part* field.
- At *File to Submit*, click on the *Choose File* button to select the file you want to submit. You may also drag the file to the *Choose File* button.
- Tick the *Notice* check box to indicate that you have read the text below.
