



Wireless Internet at the UvA

How to connect?

To establish a connection to the UvA wireless network you will first need to install the SecureW2 security software on your device (laptop, tablet or smartphone).

- If you already have an Internet connection (e.g. mobile Internet)

Go to <https://wifiportal.uva.nl>. This page checks your operating system to ensure you download the right software (e.g. for Windows, Mac OS X or Android). Check to see if the right operating system is selected and click JoinNow. The SecureW2 software will now be downloaded. Install the software on your device.

- If you are at a UvA location

Establish a connection with the UvAguests wireless network. Once your connection has been established, open your Internet browser and go to <https://www.wifiportal.uva.nl> (Internet Explorer will direct you to this page automatically). This page checks your operating system to ensure you download the right software (e.g. for Windows, Mac OS X or Android). Check to see if the right operating system is selected and click JoinNow. The SecureW2 software will now be downloaded. Install the software on your device.

After installing the software

Once you have installed the SecureW2 software you can start using wireless Internet at the UvA by selecting the 'uva' or 'eduroam' wireless networks and logging in with your UvAnetID (if you are using a Mac your UvA-net ID has to be followed by @uva.nl).
