

## **Amendment to the Teaching and Examination Regulations of the Faculty of Humanities 2021-2022 regarding admission requirements<sup>1</sup>**

*Adopted by the dean, 15 June 2021*

### **Bachelor's**

- Students who are 6 credits or fewer short of successfully completing the first year of their degree programme taught by a university of applied sciences, may apply for admission to the bachelor's programme. The student must submit a completion statement / advice from the university of applied sciences to the UvA no later than 1 August 2021.

The missing 6 credits of their degree must be obtained in the academic year 2021-2022. The right to participate in education and to take exams will lapse if the student does not complete the propaedeutic phase of their bachelor's degree at a university of applied sciences in the academic year 2021-2022.

### **Premaster's\***

- Students who are 15 credits or fewer short of successfully completing their bachelor's degree programme, may apply for admission to the premaster's programme. The missing 15 credits of their degree must be obtained in the academic year 2021-2022. The right to participate in education and to take exams will lapse if the student does not complete the bachelor's degree in the academic year 2021-2022.

### **Master's\***

- Students who have not yet completed their university bachelor's degree programme, may apply for admission to the master's programme if they obtained at least 165 credits of the bachelor's degree programme. The missing 15 credits of their degree must be obtained in the academic year 2021-2022. If the student does not meet this requirement, it is not possible to continue or graduate from the master's degree programme.

For the master's degree programmes in Heritage Studies (CROHO 60836), Archaeology (CROHO 60805), Classics and Ancient Civilizations (CROHO 60821), and the research master's degree programme in Archaeology (CROHO 60133), there is an additional requirement that the student must have completed the thesis or final dissertation of the bachelor's degree programme in order to be admitted.

- Students who are 6 credits or fewer short of completing their premaster's programme, may apply for admission to the master's degree programme. If the student does not complete the premaster's programme in the academic year 2021-2022, the student will lose the right to attend classes and to take exams.

\* For students who must complete a bachelor's degree programme outside the EEA, the relaxation of the admission requirements as mentioned in this addendum do not apply.
