To promote both inclusivity and diversity, the Faculty of Science has created the Grassroots Science4all grant. You can apply to have the diversity project you envisioned funded by the university. Last year, a total of six grants were awarded. For instance, the Women in Data Science Amsterdam project, which aims to give female data scientists and academic researchers from the Amsterdam region a platform to share their work and experiences. Another example would be the Diversity in Science talks by study association Cognito, which you can read more about below. The next call for Grassroots Science4all is planned in the autumn of 2021.

Next to these initiatives, the Faculty of Science will also incorporate inclusivity as one of the themes in its strategic plan for the coming 5 years. 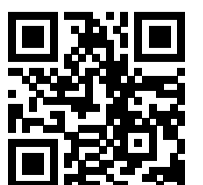
Reflect on Diversity & Inclusivity
