## Let's invest in better education!



With the transition from the basic student grant to the current loan system, the Ministry of Education, Culture and Science (OCW) has released so-called quality funds for universities. Our faculty uses this money to improve the quality of your education.

The Faculty of Science has chosen to invest in four specific themes: more time

and attention for students (1), advanced career preparation (2), community building (3) and teacher professionalisation (4). We pay a lot of attention to small-scale education by hiring more teachers. We also invest in things such as the discussion platform BètaBreak and the Teaching & Learning Centre. In addition, we prepare students for the labor market with qualitative

modules in the field of labor market orientation.
