

## 1. House rules and code of conduct at the Roeterseiland Campus



### Welcome to the Roeterseiland Campus

We are aiming for a safe and pleasant environment at our campus. Below, you can find the house rules and code of conduct applicable both within the buildings on the campus and in the grounds outside them (the area around buildings A through P), together with additional rules specifically applicable to the Roeterseiland Campus.



### Applicable law

All laws and regulations set by the government are applicable on this campus, including but not limited to the following laws and regulations that promote orderly, safe and environmentally friendly use of the campus: Section 461 of the Dutch Penal Code (*Wetboek van Strafrecht*), the Road Traffic Act 1994 (*Wegenverkeerswet 1994*), the Road Traffic and Traffic Signals Regulations 1990 (*RVV1990*) and the General Municipal Bylaw of the Municipality of Amsterdam (*APV Gemeente Amsterdam*).



### Application of house rules and code of conduct

- Depending on the nature and severity of violations, the UvA may initiate claims for civil liability against any parties who violate the house rules and the code of conduct, with all ensuing costs borne by the violator.
- The UvA/AUAS is not liable for any loss or theft of items.



### Accessibility of the buildings

The UvA strives to make access to buildings as easy and convenient as possible to students and staff with a disability. Information on all such facilities can be found via the A-Z list ([Building Accessibility](#)).



### Security

- **In case of emergency, immediately call (020 525) 2222 or notify the receptionist.**
- Do not engage in any activities that result in disturbances, contamination or hazardous situations.
- To promote everybody's safety, the UvA uses a camera surveillance system.
- The use of drugs is prohibited.
- In general, please refrain from bringing anything to campus that could be disruptive to everyday operations, could compromise security or could cause personal injury or damage to property.



### Follow instructions issued by UvA staff

Everybody on UvA premises must comply with the instructions issued by UvA staff.



### Clean and tidy

- Clear up after yourself and use the correct bins/recycling containers.



### Parking of vehicles and storage of materials

All vehicles must be parked in compliance with the instructions issued by the UvA.

The following is permitted:

- parking vehicles in the allocated parking spaces;
- parking in other areas, provided you have written permission from the UvA to do so;
- transferring goods and parking, putting away, cleaning or repairing vehicles or materials in the areas allocated by the UvA for this purpose;
- parking bicycles (folding or otherwise) in the designated bicycle parking spaces (folding bicycles may not be brought inside).

Any bicycles left in the bike parking spaces, racks or garages for more than seven days will be removed. If you discover that your bike has been removed, contact the campus managers.



### Activities or events

Under certain circumstances, activities or events can be held on campus:

- drinks receptions, conferences, graduation ceremonies and exhibitions. To organise such events, please contact the Facilities Events Coordination Department (part of Facility Services) via [servicedesk-fs@uva.nl](mailto:servicedesk-fs@uva.nl).
- Taking photographs or recording video footage is only permitted with prior permission from the Facilities Events Coordination Department of Facility Services via [servicedesk-fs@uva.nl](mailto:servicedesk-fs@uva.nl).
- If you wish to distribute flyers or carry out other similar activities, please consult the Facilities Events Coordination Department of Facility Services beforehand via [servicedesk-fs@uva.nl](mailto:servicedesk-fs@uva.nl).

Written permission for the following activities must be obtained in advance via [servicedesk-fs@uva.nl](mailto:servicedesk-fs@uva.nl):

- demonstrations;
- advertising or promotional activities (e.g. distribution of flyers, placement of posters, construction of stands, etc.);
- public speeches or charity collections;
- expressions of public and/or political beliefs;
- sale of items.

### **Follow instructions issued by UvA staff**

Everybody on UvA premises must comply with the instructions issued by UvA staff.



### **Barbecues/bonfires**

Barbecues, bonfires and fireworks are not permitted.



### **Boats**

Mooring is permitted in the designated areas, provided you have permission from the UvA and your boat carries a Waternet vignette.



### **Dogs**

Dogs must be kept on a lead everywhere on the campus. Dog dirt must be disposed of in the waste bins.
